BOP (Base Of the Pyramid): The Unreached



- Low income, Low literacy, Low property
- Low (or no) access to social services e.g. health, education, business
- •Technology/Products are not developed considering their requirements
- Recent penetration of Mobile phone and tele-centres

Why unreached?

The facts for healthcare situation

- **Doctors** don't want to stay in rural/remote areas
- Quality hospitals don't sustain without a stable income
- Transportation cost is bigger than treatment cost

Remote Health Consultancy over mobile phone



- 1. A patient calls a *hotline number*.
- 2. The call is *redirected* to a call center doctor.
- 3. The patient-doctor conversation starts.
- 4. The doctor provides *three types of services*.
- 5. The conversation is *archived in CDR*
